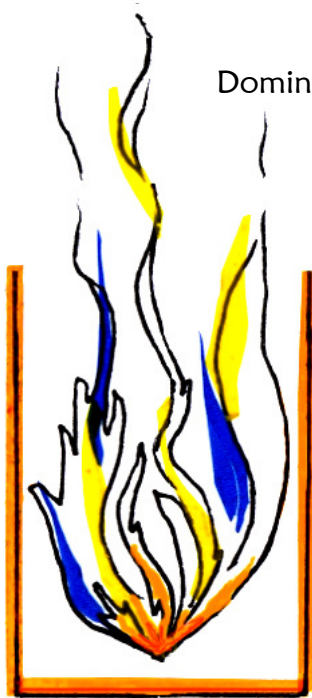
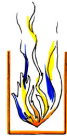

1 The Flames of Heartside *Mask-Making with Heartside Neighbors*

2 Enflamed by Song *Gregorian Chant/Music of Hildegard of Bingen*

Learn of the rich and profound music that enabled Hildegard and her Sisters to enter into prayer.

3 Burn with Peace - Meditative Card Making *Mary Ellen Robertson OPA*

(One 1-hr. studio, \$2 supply fee.)

Card making using found objects can be a form of ever-new creative reflection. Bring beauty and color to life by using ordinary things, special paper, threads and more.

4 The Heat of the Dance - Line Dancing *Mimi Priebe OPA*

(One 1-hr. studio)

This is no country western variety of line dancing. This is an experience in common movement and the joy of the dance becomes a prayer.

5 Creative Process Outside under the Tent *Phyllis Mrozinski OP*

(1-hr. studio held 2x)

Small groups of 4-5 plan & construct a sculpture with Styrofoam, using available supplies. Writers & poets may write about the idea, the process, and/or the results. Painters may paint. Musicians & singers may sing/chant a verse of praise. Those who love movement may create a dance or special gestures. "Show and Tell/Sharing" will end the session.

6 Delight in the Sparks - Spin Art *Carol O'Connor OPA*

(One 1-hr. studio, \$1 supply fee to facilitator.)

Art can be controlled and then again it can be out of control! Try your hand at Spin Art. A few blobs of color here and there and then allow the design to "happen" and let the fun begin!

7 The People on Fire *Drawings by Hiroshima Survivors*

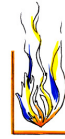

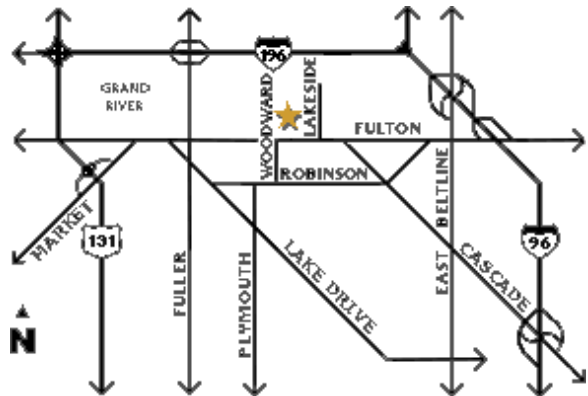

From the East: Take I-96* to Cascade Road West exit (40A). Follow Cascade Road West for 2.5 miles until it veers left and merges with E. Fulton Street. Continue West on Fulton for .5 mile. Turn right at Lakeside Drive and continue to the second entrance on left to enter Grand Rapids Dominican's campus /parking lot. * **

From the North & South: Take US 131 to the I-96* (Lansing) East exit. Follow I-96 and exit at Fuller Avenue (79). Turn right and go 1.5 miles to E. Fulton Street. Turn left and go 1.2 miles to Lakeside Drive and continue to the second entrance on the left to the parking lot. * **

From the West: From either US 131 or I-96* follow directions found in **From The North and South**.

From the Chicago: (a 3-hr. trip) Take E. I-94 into Michigan, exit onto I-96* (34) toward Holland/Grand Rapids. Follow I-96* into Grand Rapids and exit at Fuller Ave. (79). Turn right onto Fuller Ave. and go 1.5 miles to E. Fulton St. Turn left and go 1.2 miles to Lakeside Drive and continue to the second entrance on the left to the parking lot. * **

* I-96 and I-196 are two different expressways in the Grand Rapids area
